Serenity Cancer Hospice Program Includes:

- Palliative radiation for relief of tumor burden (i.e. bleeding, pain) with minimal side effects due to reduced fractal application
- Intensive pain management with the use of in-home infusion pumps for pain medication when oral medications are no longer effective or become a burden of care
- In-home visits with our Acupuncturist to help relieve symptoms of pain, nausea, sleeplessness, anxiety, and stress
- Consultation with our Naturopathic Physician for holistic solutions to pain management and other distressing symptoms
